Donald Trump Set to Back in the White House as 47th President of USA

Sarah McBride first openly transgender person elected to US Congress

WASHINGTON

DELAWARE state senator Sarah McBride won a seat in the US House of Representatives on Tuesday, making her the first openly transgender politician elected to Congress. The Democrat was the comfortable winner against Republican John Whalen III, US news

networks projected, as she built up an unassailable lead with around two-thirds of ballots counted. "Delaware has sent the message loud and clear that we must be a country that protects reproductive freedom... and that this is a democracy that is big enough for all of us," she said in a statement.

McBride told CBS in a recent interview her other priorities would be "affordable child care, paid family and medical leave, housing, health care." Transgender rights have become a hot-but-ton issue in the US election – with the participation of trans



people in competitive sports and the issue of access to gender-affirming care for minors triggering fiery debate. Democrats broadly support transgender rights but many Republicans denounce what they see as political correctness that ignores the erosion of biological

cal women's rights to their own spaces, from bathrooms and prisons to sports contests. The fight has dominated TV advertising in the White House race between Kamala Harris and Donald Trump, with the Republican accusing Democrats last year of "left-wing gender insanity" with respect to transgender youth. Nod to ₹3.6K cr scheme for higher education

Students with annual family income below ₹8 lakh to be granted loans up to ₹10 lakh with no collateral or guarantor

THE Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved the **PM-Vidyalaxmi scheme** with an allocation of ₹3,600 crore for five years to provide financial aid to meritorious students getting admitted into Quality Higher Education Institutions (QHEIs), both private and public.

The Cabinet also gave its nod for ₹10,700 crore as equity infusion in the Food Corporation of India (FCI) during 2024-25 financial year.

"A big boost to making education more accessible. The Cabinet has approved the PM-Vidyalaxmi scheme to support youngsters with quality education. It is a significant step towards empowering the Yuva Shakti and building a brighter future for our nation," Prime Minister Narendra Modi said in a post on X.

Briefing the media after the Cabinet meeting, Information and Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said, the PM-Vidyalaxmi scheme has been designed in a way that deserving candidates do not face financial constraints in pursuing quality higher education.

He said the scheme's key features stemmed from the National Education Policy 2020, as students having annual family income up to ₹8 lakh will be eligible to get 3 per cent of interest subvention for the educa-

tion loans up to ₹10 lakh and there will be no requirement of collateral and guarantor. "The entire process of availing the loan facility will be simple and in end-to-end digital format used by all scheduled government and private banks," the minister added.

Lauding the decision, Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan said, "It is a significant initiative to provide financial support to meritori-

ous students under the Central sector. The scheme will help universalise access to 21st-century higher education for India's talented youth."

Later, in a notification, the government said that through a mission-oriented approach, education loans "will be extended to qualified students entering the top 860 prestigious higher education institutions in the country, benefitting over 22 lakh students annually, as an

amount of ₹3,600 crore has been allocated for the period between 2024-25 and 2030-31."

The department of higher education is introducing a consolidated portal, called PM-Vidyalaxmi, where students can easily apply for education loans and interest subvention from all banks. "The scheme will supplement the Central Sector Interest Subsidy, and Credit Guarantee Fund Scheme for Education Loans, the two com-

ponent schemes of PM-USP (Uchchatar Shiksha Protsahan) being implemented by the department of higher education," the statement read.

Through the PM-USP CSIS programme, students from families with an annual income of up to ₹4.5 lakh, who are enrolled in technical or professional courses at approved institutions, are eligible for full interest subvention on education loans up to ₹10 lakh during the moratorium period.

"PM Vidyalaxmi and PM-USP will together provide holistic support to all deserving students to pursue higher education in quality HEIs and technical or professional education in approved HEIs," it added.

Vaishnaw said, "Cabinet approves infusion of equity of ₹10,700 crore for working capital in 2024-25 in FCI." He added that in the past 10 years, "the scale of FCI operations has expanded due to the increase in Minimum Support Price and procurement of food grains. Therefore, the decision aims to enhance the operational capabilities of FCI to fulfil its mandate effectively."

The FCI typically resorts to short-term borrowings to address funding requirements, but this equity infusion "is expected to reduce FCI's interest burden, ultimately lowering the government's subsidy burden," the minister said.

Collateral-Free Loans for Students in Quality Institutions:

Under this scheme, students securing admission to top 860 Quality Higher Education Institutions (QHEIs), as per the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), will be eligible for loans covering tuition and other academic expenses. An initial outlay of ₹3,600 crore has been allocated, expected to benefit over 22 lakh students annually. The loan amount, up to ₹7.5 lakh, includes a 75% credit guarantee, helping banks and financial institutions extend loans with minimal risk.

For these students, a 3% interest subvention on loans up to ₹10 lakh will be provided during the moratorium period, prioritizing students from government institutions pursuing technical or professional courses.

This subvention is expected to aid around 7 lakh new students through 2030-31.

President Murmu to get onboard INS Vikrant, witness naval ops today

PRESIDENT Droupadi Murmu will be onboard indigenous aircraft carrier INS Vikrant and witness naval operations on Thursday.

The Indian Navy said this is the maiden sailing of the Supreme Commander of Indian Armed Forces onboard aircraft carrier INS Vikrant to witness the full spectrum of multi-domain naval operations."

The scheduled operations include surface ships ops, battle actions, submarine exercises, air power demo including take-off and landings by deck-based fighter aircraft/ helicopters and a flypast by naval aircraft, the Navy said.

Admiral Dinesh K Tripathi, the Chief of the Naval Staff, will receive the President at INS Hansa (Naval Air Station at Goa) and present a 150-men Ceremonial Guard of Honour. Soon after, the President will embark the indigenous aircraft carrier INS Vikrant at the sea off Goa.

The INS Vikrant is the largest ship ever built in the maritime history of India and has



76% indigenous content which includes the equipment and machinery, involving major industrial houses in the country as well as over 100 MSMEs. The keel of INS Vikrant was laid in February 2009 and it was commissioned in September 2022.

The aircraft carrier is named in honour of her historic predecessor, India's first aircraft carrier, which played an important part in the war of 1971. The 19,500-tonne INS Vikrant was the first ever carrier for an Asian country and remained so for a long time.

It is designed by the Indian

Navy's in-house Warship Design Bureau (WDB) and built by Cochin Shipyard Limited; a public sector shipyard under the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways. Vikrant has been built with state-of-the-art automation features.

The 262.5 m long and 61.6 m wide Vikrant displaces approx 43,000 T, having a maximum designed speed of 28 knots with endurance of 7,500 nautical miles. The ship has around 2,200 compartments, designed for a crew of around 1,600, including women officers and sailors.

India Submits Formal Bid for 2036 Olympics

India has officially submitted a Letter of Intent to the International Olympic Committee (IOC) for the 2036 Olympic and Paralympic Games, marking a significant step in realizing Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of hosting the prestigious event. The bid was submitted by the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) on October 1, 2023, as part of the ongoing effort to elevate India's global sporting profile. This would be the first time India hosts the Olympics, fulfilling a dream long cherished by its citizens.

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Cabinet nod to key policies, Land Act

THE State Cabinet approved the AP Drone Policy 2024-29, Data Centre Policy 4.0, and AP Semiconductor Fab Policy 4.0 during a meeting chaired by Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu on Wednesday.

As part of the Drone Policy, the State government has proposed to set up a training institute for drone pilots and developing Kurnool district as a drone manufacturing hub. The policy envisages an investment of ₹1,000 crore, revenue of ₹3,000 crore, and the creation of 15,000 direct and 25,000 indi-

rect jobs. Additionally, the Cabinet decided to repeal the AP Land Grabbing (Prohibition) Act, 1982 and bring a new law in its place.

Briefing media on the decisions, Minister for Information and Public Relations (I&PR) Kolusu Parthasarathi said the State is moving fast towards transforming into a drone hub. The decision to set up a Drone Development Centre in Kurnool is to achieve this goal.

Expressing confidence that the policy, adopted by the Cabinet, will enable the establishment of at least 100 drone man-

ufacturing units in the State, he said the move will result in the setting up of 20 drone pilot training centres and 50 skill development centres across the State.

On the Data Centre Policy, he said, the initiative aims at adding an additional 200 megawatts of data and attracting investments for setting up latest data centres with Artificial Intelligence (AI). "The Council of Ministers also approved the Andhra Pradesh Semiconductor Fab policy which will be in force between 2024 and 2029," he added.

It has been decided to increase the retirement age of judicial officers in AP by one year. This increase will be effective from November 1. He said that the Cabinet has given approval to increase the retirement age of judicial officers to 61 from November 1, 2024.

MP ups women quota in state services to 35%

THE Madhya Pradesh cabinet has cleared a proposal to increase the reservation for women in all state government services from the current 33 per cent to 35 per cent.

The decision was taken at a cabinet meeting chaired by Chief Minister Mohan Yadav on Tuesday. "This a major decision for ensuring women empowerment in the state. The women reservation in direct recruitments to all departments has been increased from 33% to 35%. This will be applicable to the entire recruitment process conducted by the MP Public Service Commission (MPPSC) and Employee Selection Board (ESB) across all departments in the state," deputy chief minister Rajendra Shukla told reporters after the state cabinet meeting.

According to the state government's official statement, the cabinet meeting ratified the Madhya Pradesh Civil Services (Special Provisions for Appointment of Women) Rules, 1997, the order of the Chief Minister (then CM Shivraj Singh Chouhan) dated September 13, 2023 and the subsequent notification dated October 3,

It will apply to all direct recruitment exercises carried out by the MP Public Service Commission (MPPSC) and the MP State Employees Selection Board



MORE POWER TO WOMEN

To be applicable to all categories, including the unreserved category as well as the reserved categories

This means that even in jobs reserved for different castes (SC, ST and OBC), 35% of jobs for each category will go to women candidates.

The decision to hike the women reservation in government jobs in MP was made during the previous BJP regime headed by Shivraj Singh Chouhan in Sept 2023

2023 issued by the department to increase women's reservation to 35 per cent. In addition to the reservation policy, the cabinet approved several other measures aimed at improving the state's infrastructure and investment climate.

The cabinet decided that the state government will reimburse the possible expenditure on human resources up to the maximum limit of ₹1.72 crore for setting up 254 new fertiliser sales centres in the year 2024-25 (kharif and rabi seasons).

Further, in view of the shortage of medical teachers in new government medical colleges, the cabinet approved to increase the maximum age limit

for appointment to the vacant posts of assistant professor from 40 years to 50 years.

"As the maximum age for senior residency is 45 years and being an SR (senior resident) is necessary to apply for the assistant professor post, hence the maximum age limit for assistant professor's appointment in medical colleges of the state has been increased to 50 years," deputy CM Shukla said.

The cabinet also gave in-principle approval to the project for computerisation of the Registrar of Cooperative Societies office of the state under the centrally sponsored project, 'Strengthening of Cooperatives through IT Interventions', im-

plemented by the Union ministry of cooperation. This will cost ₹3.68 crore, of which 60 per cent amount will be borne by the Centre and 40 per cent by the state government.

The cabinet approved the establishment of a 660 MW critical thermal power plant in Sarni. This project will replace older power units totalling 830 MW, addressing energy needs more efficiently. Shukla also reflected on the success of the recent Regional Industrial Conclave in Rewa, which attracted around 4,000 investors and business leaders. This event yielded investment proposals worth ₹31,000 crore and promises to create over 28,000 jobs in the state.
